 - 2007:** added new medical imaging wing to house a fixed MRI unit and Women's Diagnostic Services (including bone densitometry, breast MRI and stereotactic breast biopsy)
 - 2010:** remodeled lower level for new kitchen/cafeteria with expanded dining hours and conference center (Bryant Health Education Center) with state of the art audiovisual technology for community education and employee meetings
 - 2015:** Parking lot improvement project which provided additional parking spaces, safer environment and improved look to the entire campus
 - 2016 to 2017:** 15,000 square feet new space expansion and 20,000 square feet renovation of Emergency, Urgent Care, Lab, Day Surgery, Registration and Ambulatory Infusion Center
 - 2018:** Remodel and technology upgrade of Medical Imaging Department, OrthoTeam Madison Clinic moves to a larger location
