Mr. DeGroot provided an overview of Stoughton Health's FY2023 Strategic Plan and noted the plan will be updated as the environment changes. Mr. Fendrick thanked Mr. DeGroot for his engagement and dedication within the community, state and with WHA. It was asked which payers are dominant in Dane and Rock Counties. Margo answered that Quartz has the most covered lives in Dane County while Dean Health Plan has the majority of Rock County covered lives.

5. Board Self-Evaluation Process Preference

Mr. DeGroot asked Board members what type of approach they would like to take for conducting Board Self-Evaluations. Ms. Olson added she would find benefit in survey questions being sent ahead of time so Board members can review/complete before scheduled 1:1 meetings to discuss.

## 6. Open Discussion

Mr. Probst asked if there was insight as to why survey results in the Urgent Care are not as strong for younger adults. Mr. DeGroot noted some of these results are related to longer urgent care wait times which the younger demographic doesn't like and added the team is currently reviewing
