What is Project One?

Project One is an organizational initiative designed to achieve standardized and optimized technology and processes across our health system. Nurse Well-being is a phase of Project One, with a focus on streamlined documentation for the inpatient med surg nurses. More meaningful Storyboard, Summary Reports and Admission Navigator with reduced documentation fields, more purposeful choices, less banners, and BPAs as designed by SSM clinicians.

Why a Special Edition Newsletter?

Nurse Well-being Wave 1 focus is IP Med Surg, ICU, Tele, and Stepdown nurses **<u>BUT</u>** standardization will improve documentation efficiency and consistency throughout the system. This means additional nursing roles will see changes.

New Feature	Macros	Documentation Efficiency	 System macros (6) in Navigators allow commonly documented answers to populate documentation with one click. Macros are named to describe the action of the macro. Hover on a macro name to see the default responses highlighted in the form. Click the macro button and all the answers flow in. Edit answers as needed. Personal Macros can be created in navigators and Flowsheets. Look for the macro manager button in your navigator section toolbar or flowsheet toolbar. 			
Quick Win	Banners and BPAs	Less Interruption of Workflow	 Banners and BPAs have been reevaluated, rewritten, and, in some cases removed. Banners are to provide more purposeful wording and direction. BPAs are to be sent to the right person at the right time.

Global immunizations have been renamed Vaccine Assessments.
